- What is the composition / layout like? How is the image arranged? What is in the foreground / background?
- ➤ How would you describe the colour scheme? Can you identify any specific colour groups? E.g. harmonious, complementary, warm, cool.
- What types of lines, shapes, forms, tones, textures, or patterns have been used?

- How do you think the artwork was made? Which media technique was used? E.g. pencil, paint. Why do you think this?
- What is your own opinion of the artist's style? (Likes & dislikes are both important).
- Do you think there might be a meaning / message / story behind the artwork? Explain clearly and use examples.

- How does this artwork / style link to the project / theme you are currently studying in Art?
- Which 3 ideas could you take from the artwork / artist to inspire your own work?
- What would you do differently to the artist? How could you improve the image? What other ideas do you have after studying this artwork?
