

In MFL vocab learning is crucial for listening and reading, but also for manipulating language for speaking and writing. **Ideally pupils will do a little each day rather than the 10 000 on one day.** This is the best way to ensure retention of vocabulary.

Ideally pupils aiming to improve on their target grades will complete **10 000 points each week**, not just on the weeks they have homework. Pupils are not limited to 10 000, this is a minimum and rewards for the highest scorers will be given.
