




































































































How did he start being a designer?












- 4. He designed two notable chairs for Kartell.
 - Using polycarbonate, he created the first completely transparent chair in the world. The robust La Marie chair is unexpectedly light and shock resistant.
 - He also created the Louis ghost dining chair modeled after the Louis XVI armchair. It sold more than 1.5 million units, making it the world's hest selling designer chair.
- 5. His goal is to improve as many people's lives as possible.
 - He designs objects to the best of their means, always economical and never wasteful. He
 believed that before being beautiful, something must first be useful. This is best seen in the
 products he has designed, which are affordable and found in mass-market venues.
 - His creations are also imbued with playfulness to make daily tasks exciting. A hat is
 placed on top of his Chapp lamp to serve as a lampshade. The idea was derived from Fred
 Astaire and James Stewart whose characters threw their hats at the nearest object upon
 arriving home.
- 6. The French government has given him national honors and prestigious positions.
 - He was appointed the artistic director for the French presidency of the European Union in 2008
 - During the following year, he was named the Ambassador of Creativity and Innovation for France






Technology Coco Chanel

Coco Chanel started out as a cabaret singer, however she came into the fashion world by designing hats. Coco Chanel learned the art of sewing at the orphanage (where she grew up). She became a licensed milliner in 1910 and opened a boutique at 21 rue Cambon, Paris, named Chanel Modes. Her first clients were simple women but the important figures soon followed.

Coco Chanel gave us the most famous perfume, Chanel No 5. The perfume was launched in 1921 and had its place in history secured when Marilyn Monroe was asked what she wore to bed and she answered "Just a few drops of Chanel No 5". It was called Chanel No 5 as it was the 5th scent from her samples. She was pretty simple with the names of her products.


Chanel revolutionized women's fashion when she freed them from the "dresses in which one can't move". The famous Chanel suit has a military-inspired jacket, pad pockets and buttons that look like jewelry. Around the age of 20, Chanel became involved with Etienne Balsan, who offered to help her start a millinery business in Paris. She soon left him for one of his wealthier friends, Arthur "Boy" Capel. Both men were instrumental in Chanel's first fashion venture.
