| What are the times of the school day? | The school day will be 8.40am-2.30pm. If students walk or are transported via car they will leave site at 2.30pm. If students depart via school transport they will leave site between 2.30-2.40pm. We have slightly reduced the school day by half an hour to reduce student movement around the school site during the day and to allow us to stagger the school buses at the end of the day. Please note the students still receive 25 hours learning time. | | |
| Is it compulsory to send my child to school? | It is vital that all children return to school to benefit their education, wellbeing and wider development. In line with government guidance, from September, attendance will be mandatory and the usual school rules on attendance will apply. | | |
| Expected Uniform | To maintain our school ethos and high expectations of behaviour, the wearing of school uniform is compulsory. We ask that Parents/Carers continue to support the school in ensuring that their children attend school wearing the correct uniform in September. *We are aware that a number of students have been unable to obtain a school tie due to limited supply, be assured that this is not an issue and no student will receive a sanction* Please see the school website for the uniform expectations. Please note the hair and piercing policy. Parents/Carers will be contacted if students do not adhere to our policy. Students will be expected to attend school equipped for all lessons. This includes a pencil case and PE kit. Students will not be able to borrow equipment due to cross contamination. We would encourage students to be as self sufficient as possible with a labelled and lidded drinks bottle, as access to water is limited. Please note that in the canteen, if a student buys a meal deal they will receive a bottled drink for free. | | |
