Dear Parent / Carer,

As a school we are fully committed to giving our students a full range of careers related activities to prepare students for the future. As part of our Careers Education and STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) programmes, we have organised two important events for students to attend.

Year 9 students will firstly be attending ACE Day at Hull University on the 12 June 2019. The aim of the day is to raise awareness of higher education and to encourage students to understand the benefits of continuing their education at University. The programme is a full day of activities covering all aspects of higher education, such as entry routes, loans, sponsorship and reasons for entering higher education. There will also be a tour of the university campus. Students will be assisted by university students who are generously giving up their time to participate.

Secondly, students will be attending the Big Bang Fair (Yorkshire and Humber). The Big Bang events take place across the country and our local event will be held at Doncaster Racecourse on 25 June 2019. As part of the day, students will be attending an hour long science workshop. During the rest of the event students will be able to visit a range of stands, exhibitions and hands-on activities linked to a wide range of STEM careers.

Both visits will take place during the school day. We will leave at 9:00am and return in time for the school buses at 3:00pm. Students will need to wear school uniform for both the visits and will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink.

There will be one total contribution of £14:50 towards the cost of transport to both events. Please pay online using Partenpay (**we cannot accept cash or cheques**). If we do not receive enough contributions the events may not be able to take place.

The aim is to inspire and engage young people to consider future education and career pathways they may not have considered.
