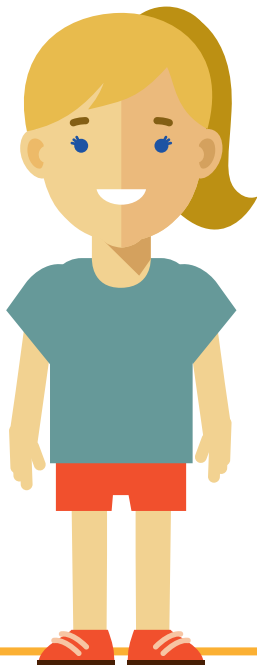

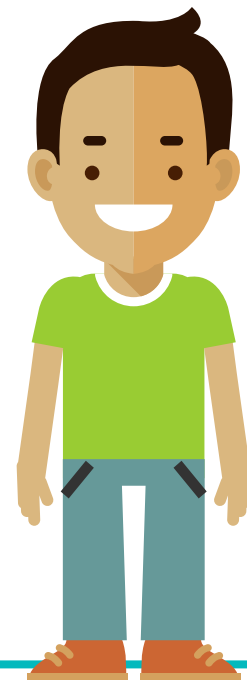
### Jenny
